Darren used the same method as the winner and hooked into a couple of lumps that helped his finishing total. John Male showed once again that he can catch on all methods besides the pole. John caught most of his 37-5 on the feeder from peg 35 near the entrance to the pool. John could have added to his total weight but for some reason he started to pack up some 20 minutes before the end.

Ian Rennie was back to something like his old self after a couple of disappointing matches to finish Fourth. Ian lost a good fish right from the off but put that behind him to put 31-14 on the scales.

Newcomer this season Andy Taylor finished in Fifth place with 31-12 just two ounces shy of Fourth spot and Dave Robinson who is still struggling with his bad back ended in Sixth with 27-13.

A special word for Alan Whitmore who landed the biggest fish of the day a 9-8 lump from peg 25.

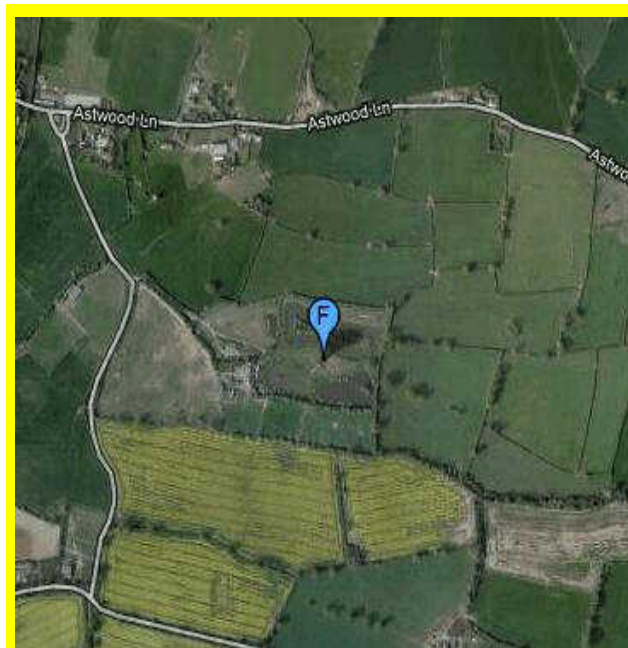

RULES

Whilst there are few rules only Fishery pellets should be used although anglers can use their own hooker pellets. Permitted baits are Sweet corn, Luncheon Meat, Maggots, Casters, Worms, Sinking bread and Hooker Pellets. Keepnets in matches only and must be dipped. Fishery pellets are available from the Fishery office. All rubbish must be removed from your peg on completion of match. Strictly only barbless hooks to be used.
