

#### RULES

Barbless hooks must be used, maximum size 10. All nets must be dipped prior to fishing Handle fish with care, do not wrap a fish in clothes or rags. EA License required. No Hemp or groudbait of any king, No Braid, No floating baits, No bread at all. No fixed method feeders or bolt rigs or fixed leads or feeders. No floating poles / a float must be used. No tapping or cupping water / splashing or helicopter methods. No liquidised baits, you cannot feed meat or macaroni. No seafood baits of any kind, Prawns, mussells. **You can use on the hook (If it's not listed you cant use it)** Meat, Corn, Maggots, Castors, Worms, Macaroni Cheese, Hooker Pellets, Paste (made from our pellets) **You can feed (if its not listed you cant use it)** Pellets (must be brought from us), Corn, Maggots and castors are limited to 2 pints in total, Worms. Please do not throw unused bait into the pool when finished fishing.
