No Dog meat or Cat meat, No Boilies, No Trout Pellets, No hempseed, seed baits or nuts,

No Macaroni cheese, No floating baits, No floating poles, No Groundbait,

No spinning or live baiting, No Joker or Bloodworm, No method feeders or fixed bolt rigs,

No elasticsation on any feeder rig, No braided mainline and hook lengths, No free lining.

First bite lodge will be open from 07.00 - 13.00

And will offer a wide range of hot and cold food

The lodge will also sell a small section of baits.
