JUAN'S TON HELPS HIMSELF AND ROB TO THE DOUBLES CROWN



Juan Pereira and Rob Cox collected the 2015 Doubles crown by virtue of weight countback when they finished on the same number of points as Mary Turner and John Male. Juan played a big part in the victory by posting the biggest weight of the day 104-08 from peg 7 on the Laurel Pool at Cob House. Rob Cox who put 25 pound on the scales from the Oak Pool made it a personal double celebration he's 51 today.

Mary Turner and John Male pushed the winners all the way with Mary landing the top weight on the Oak with 60-09 from Peg 1 while John chipped in with 38-06 from Laurel. Mary took the early lead in the Biggest fish of the season competition when she landed an 11 lb Carp using the feeder.

Steve Cox and Alan Martin took the Third spot with Nine points, four more than the leading two. Alan scaled 35-04 which was enough for Six points on Laurel whilst his partner Steve took Three Points on the Oak with 31-08.



Three pairs ended up on 11 points and to be separated by overall weight to see who took the brown envelope. Ian Rennie and the Langley Wizard Alan Whitmore collected the honours when they mustered 79-12. Ian was a little unlucky when he lost a good un mid-match which could have pushed them closer to the third spot.

Next best of the trio was Sean Durrant and Brian Tovey who totaled 67-08 between them. Brian had a good day on Laurel with 56.08 while Sean had a disappointing day with only 11-0.

Colin Parsonage and Darren Bullock finished Third of the 11 points brigade with a total of 53-09.

The weights were well down on the normally prolific Cob House Fishery, I think this was mainly down to the weather which started OK but when the strong winds appeared it was like fishing in the sea. The top weights on the day were by those who selected the feeder attack. John Male was not having a good day on the Laurel after a couple of hours in he managed to break his landing net handle, but with a little help from Pete Bullock they landed the fish.

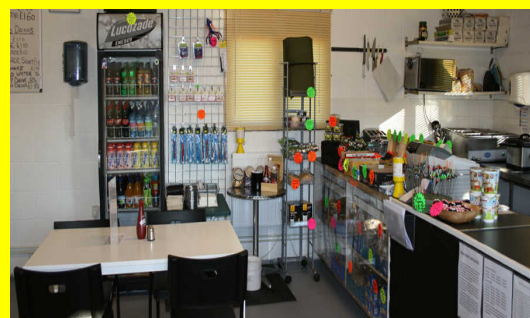

THE CLUBHOUSE



Named after the magnificent 1,000-year-old oak tree which stands near the clubhouse, Oak Pool was developed as an out-and-out pleasure and club match carp and tench water. Originally stocked with a good head of common and mirror carp to 12lbs 8oz, small number of grass carp and thousands of green and golden tench to about 12oz, these fish have not only grown on nicely but spawn in the pool giving anglers good nets of mixed fish.

Fishing from 30 slabbed pegs with a central island being the main feature of the water. Depths range from just three-and-a-half feet along the bank where the bullrushes have taken hold, to a maximum depth of seven to eight feet just out from the car park bank. This bank also has the benefit of a four feet deep shelf which runs about three feet out from the side.

Anglers have good results from pole, waggler and feeder fishing with fishing in the margins, in open water or against the island all being equally productive. Most popular baits include plain and flavoured luncheon meat, maggots, pellets, sweetcorn.
