Looking at the League tables, despite missing the last match Kieran Smith holds a slender one point lead at the top of Division One but this looks like turning into a fascinating tussle with only three points covering the top six. ## RULES

Keepnets are only allowed in matches, Anglers must provide two nets which must be dried out and not put into the water until 15 minutes before the match commences. A 60 lb weight limit per net.

Landing nets must be dipped.

Barbless hooks only, maximum size 10 hook.

No braided line of any form to be used.

No Tiger or peanuts allowed.

No liquidised meat allowed - ie Luncheon meat  
Cat Food can be used on the hook - cannot be loose fed

No Bloodworm or Joker.

Floating baits can be used on hook - not loose fed.

Halibut, trout or any high oil pellets are not allowed.

Maximum of 3 pints/1 kg of pellets in 5 hours.

Please use litter bins provided, any angler found to have left litter will not be allowed back onto the fishery.

All fishermen must have a current EA Licence.  
Fish must not be removed from pool to pool and under no circumstances be taken away from the fishery. Contrevention of this rule will result in prosecution.

The fishery reserves the right to change any rules at any time without notice.
