Juan Pereira still Leads Division Three but his lead Has been cut to Four points. Juan Could only pick Up Five points at

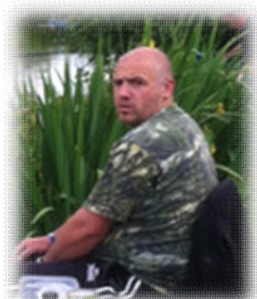
