VERY CLOSE WITH THREE MATCHES TO GO

With just three matches to go in the 2016 season things are very close in all three divisions.

Rob Cox moved to the top of the First Division due to his better overall weight replacing Peter Bullock who remains level on points both having 16. John Male moved into third place with a good showing at Alvechurch, but if he looks over his shoulder he will notice that the next three members are very close Kieran and Ian are on 24 and just a point behind is Dave Skinner with 25. Steve Cox is seventh with 30 and Darren Bullock is on 35 in eighth.

With Mark Jones having to miss the Alvechurch match it's allowed Andy Taylor to gain the top spot in Division Two but just like the first division its only due his better overall weight. Level with Andy is Paul Hotchkiss who has taken the last two divisional wins. Behind the two leaders we have Dave Robinson and Juan Periera both on 23 points a point clear of Mark Jones who is a point clear of Sean Durrant. John King is seventh on 28 and he is followed by Dave Crosby who is on 35.

Brian Tovey has extended his lead in Division Three to Three points with a good performance at Alvechurch. Colin Parsonage took full advantage of Bob Hinks poor result to move into second place with Bob now down in third place on 23 points. Only two points separate the next three members, Mary Turner is fourth on 24, Alan Martin is fifth with 25 a point clear of Jeff Turner on 26. Ian Hughes is Seventh with 34 and Alan Whitmore has 41.
