Sean Durrant claimed his second victory of the season by winning a close contest on the Horseshoe Lake at Alvechurch Fishery. Pegged on the right hand side of the lake on 27 Sean used the pole and the feeder to scale just over 35 pound with a mixed bag of Carp and Silvers.

Pushing Sean all the way and gaining his highest finish to-date with Exel Angling was Juan Pereira. The Spanish angler used the feeder to good effect close to the island but fell just short by nine ounces, but he can be very proud of his second place finish.

It's a shame third placed Steve Kavanagh has work commitments which forced him out of the club. Making a guest appearance Steve finished with 28-14 from the favoured peg 11. The outcome could have been better but for a few lost fish.

Fourth placed Dave Skinner is enjoying his fishing at present and claimed his second brown envelope on the trot. Dave was in the next peg to the second placed angler and used the same tactics but could not catch consistently enough to trouble the first three.

There was a right match going on for fifth and sixth positions between Mark Jones and Dave Crosby who where pegged next to each other. It was Mark who came out on top by just Five ounces which left Dave wondering what might have been. Newcomer Jeff Turner finished seventh with 16-3.

If two or more are on the same number of points overall weight will decide the positions.

Sean Durrant continues to lead the way in the First Division with a perfect score of three points which is Three clear of second placed Mark Jones. The leading two are dominating the proceedings at the moment with three firsts and seconds. Rob Cox is holding onto third place by a single point just in front of John Male who is beginning to put some good scores together. Steve Cox moved into Fifth spot a point clear of Micky Small who is finding the big weights hard to come by at present. Darren Bullock narrowed the gap at the bottom to a single point but he is still chasing his brother Pete.

It's getting interesting at the top of Division Two, Kieran Smith leads the way with a three point lead but the battle for second spot continues with just one point separating the next three. Ian Rennie with a narrow overall weight advantage is in second, but Dave Crosby is pushing him all the way. Two Divisional wins on the trot see's Dave Skinner move into contention and he holds a two point lead over John King. Colin Parsonage and Bob Hinks are having a scrap for sixth place with the former just edging it with a better overall weight. Brian Tovey remains in eighth. The see-saw battle at the top of the Division Three continues, the lead has changed hands again with Jeff Turner taking over at the top with a useful result at Alvechurch. Paul Hotchkiss dropped down to second but he is only a point behind. Only two points are separating the next Three, Dave Robinson who is struggling for form is on 10 closely followed by Alan Whitmore and Alan Martin brings up the trio on 12. Juan Pereira gained a Division win at Alvechurch and is now only three points behind Alan. Ian Hughes is not having a good season to date and he failed to trouble the scales in the recent match and finds himself down in seventh. I have not heard anything from Rob Parsonage regards him missing recent matches and he remains in eighth.

Barbless Hooks only, Handle Fish with Care, No Cloths or Rags,  
Return the fish to the water in a landing net, Maximum hook size 10,  
No keepnets except in matches, Nets must be dipped prior to fishing,  
EA License is required, children under 12 must be accompanied,  
No dogs allowed, No Braid, No Hemp or Groudbait of any kind,  
No fixed method feeders or bolt rigs or fixed leads or feeders

No Floating baits, No floating poles /a float must be used,

No tapping or cupping water / splashing or helicopter methods,

No Liquidised baits, you cannot feed meat or Macaroni,

**You can use on the hook (if its not listed you cant use it)**

Meat, Corn, Maggots, Castors, Worms, Macaroni Cheese

Hooker Pellets, Paste (made from our pellets)

**You can Feed (if its not listed you cant use it)**

Pellets (must be brought from us), Corn, maggots (2 pint limit),

Castors (2 pint Limit), Wors
