

TACKLE SHOP

The new tackle shop at Fisherwick Lakes supply tackle from Wychwood, Leeda, M.A.P, Middy, 30 Plus, NGT, Grandslam. They also supply various baits.

RULES

All nets must be dry before putting into the water, time to allow for this must be given before match starts.

Minimum Two Keepnets, max 40 lb per

No tipping of fish down nets at weigh in, careful handling reduces damage to fish skin and scales.

All fish must be landed in a landing net, no swinging fish to hand.

Barbless hooks only, max size 12.

No floaters, boilies, seed or nuts to be used in match lakes.

No Cat Meat.

Only Fishery feed pellets allowed, these can be purchased at the Lodge.

Groundbait in Feeder or Pole cups only. No unused bait to be thrown in water.
