Mark made the victory a little easier by producing the best weight on the day with 63-08 from peg 19. Dave Crosby was second in section One with a level 17 pound, while Mary struggled in section Two but she did enough to gain 6 points and the victory. The Three Musketeers' produced the same three section standings as the winners, John Male got off to a cracking start from peg 4 just by the entrance landing some nice Carp but then had to wait until the final hour before securing his section win. Dave Skinner landed an all Carp bag for 34-10 in section Three which gave him two points and just like the winners Paul Hotchkiss found the going hard in the middle section before finishing on the same weight as Mary and six points. The Favourites before the off 118 finished in third place, Ian Rennie, Dave Robinson, and Sean Durrant fell a point short of first and second but they did enough weight wise to relegate Hop Along's into Fourth place. Hop Along's made up of Ian Hughes, Rob Cox, and Bob Hinks put together a good team performance but they fell short by some 10 pound.

BUDDLEIA LAKE

Is rectangular in shape with three central islands, it has 44 well spaced pegs and was originally stocked with Silver Fish and Tench. In 2002 a large number of Carp were introduced transforming it into a general all-round water. Six feet deep all over, the islands are between 14 and 16 metres from the bank.

Most popular baits tend to be Sweetcorn and Luncheon Meat for those anglers after the Carp.

RULES

Whilst there are few rules, only the fishery own feeder pellets should be used although anglers can use their own hooker pellets. Permitted baits are Sweetcorn, Luncheon Meat, Maggots, Casters, Worms, Sinking Bread and Hooker Pellets. Keepnets in matches only and both hooker pellets and feeder pellets are available from the office.



SINGLES SEMI-FINALS

Our singles semi-finals will take place at Astwood Fishery and in the last Four we have three first division anglers along with a sole second division member. All Four taking part have won their group stage with only Kieran Smith winning all of his matches. In the semi-finals Kieran will be taking on Rob Cox who qualified by winning Group A with better overall weight after winning four of his five matches.

In the other last Four clash the defending champion Sean Durrant will be facing Peter Bullock. After losing his opening match against his brother, Peter dominated Group B with a three point advantage.
