Rob Cox, Steve Cox, and Lou Hughes happily named Two Cox and Coxless ran out winners of the Teams of Three competition at Bonehill Mill Fishery. At the weigh in Lou Hughes from Peg 2 gained Four section points with 23-2 which was matched by Steve Cox in Section Two with 27-6. Rob Cox helped his team to victory by winning section 3 with 54-4 which was the fourth best weight overall.

The winning team ended with Nine points, one ahead of three sides who all finished on 10 and the minor places had to be decided on weight count back. Micky Small proved to be the star of Second placed Master Baiters putting together the day's top weight 74-15 which won him Section two. Ian Rennie used the feeder from peg 7 to put 46-14 on the scales to collect two points and the third member John King can count himself unlucky in Section Three finishing with 27-5 which would have gave him sufficient points in other section's to give his side victory.

Third place went to the Mad Lad's who were made up of Dave Skinner, Alan Martin, and Mark Jones who fell close to 20 pound short on count back. Dave gained three points in Section one with 38-2 which was good considering he never a bite in the first hour. Alan powered his way to second in section two with 56 pound and last years winner Mark with 36-5 finished fifth in section three.

Team Toss Pots ended in fourth spot just outside the price money which was a shame because they had the winner of Section One John Male with 57-14 and second in section three Sean Durrant with 53-4. The third member of the side Alan Whitmore just could not get going from 11 ending with 4-10.

It was nice to see Steve Kavanagh back on the bank when fishing for fifth placed The Unlikely Lad's who finished on 11 points. Steve Kavanagh (28-15), Dave Crosby (48-14), and Colin Parsonage (15-12). Silver Surfers had to settle for sixth spot and they were made up of Bob Hinks (15-0), Darren Bullock (13-7), and Dave Robinson (38-5).

Down in Seventh was The No Mark's who mustered 19 points from venue regular Kieran Smith (30-0), Brian Tovey (13-0), and Ian Hughes (9-14).

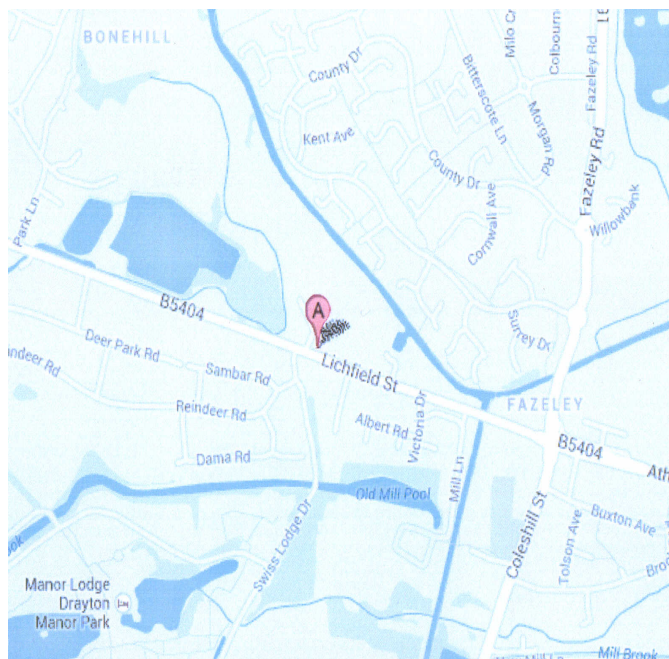
