Ian landed some nice looking Carp in that fruitful last hour all on the feeder.

It was nice to see Alan Martin back on the bank for the first time this season and he put together a nice mixed bag of Carp and Silvers for 17-13. Fishing from peg 31 on the far side of the pool Alan could not get a bite on the feeder which soon changed when he went on the waggler.

We had a tie for the third placed envelope with both Ian Hughes and Pete Bullock both registering 16 pound. Ian Hughes used the same tactic as Alan Martin fishing the waggler at mid distance on the match pool and he put a similar looking bag of mixed Carp and Silvers onto the scales. Pete Bullock fished from peg 28 near the corner and landed a 7lb lump near the end of the match which helped him share the third place prize. He used various methods during the five hours Long pole, Waggler, and in the margins.

Kieran Smith finished in fifth place with 15-12 which helped him to win the section whilst Dave Skinner collected sixth place with 11-8.
