RECORDS SMASHED AT COB HOUSE



Kieran Smith reclaimed the clubs individual weight record after putting a superb 228-2 on the scales at our doubles event at the Cob House Fishery in Worcestershire.

The old record was beaten by four members in what can only be described as a fantastic day. Pete Bullock, Mark Jones, Ian Rennie, and Dave Robinson all beat the old mark. Another Six members weighed in over one hundred pounds which meant that half of the 22 taking part registered three figure weights. The six were Dave Skinner, Dave Crosby, Juan Pereira, Paul Hotchkiss, Darren Bullock, and Steve Kavanagh. Two others came within a whisker of adding to the total Ian Hughes and Mary Turner.



MARK AND DAVE WIN THE DOUBLES BUT IT WAS VERY CLOSE



Mark Jones and Dave Robinson held their nerve to collect the Doubles Championship by a single point at Cob House Fishery. Both Mark and Dave put over one hundred pound onto the scales but they had an anxious wait right up until the final weigh in to secure their title. Mark used mainly maggots in the margins to put 147-14 on to the scales while his partner also used the margins to good effect when netting 173-0 with pellets the main bait.

Kieran Smith was well gutted after his superb 228-2 being the top weight of the day but he and his partner Dave Skinner fell just a single point short of the winners. Kieran used the pole throughout while Dave caught most of his 100-12 on the feeder.

Another partnership to both put over one hundred pound on the scales was Dave Crosby and Darren Bullock who managed to finish in third spot with 10 points. Dave caught a couple of lumps off his corner peg to land 102-10 while Darren caught well throughout the match to finish with 101-0.

By virtue of weight countback Ian Rennie (157-12) and John Male (40-0) finished in fourth place just edging out Jeff Turner (69-13) and Steve Kavanagh (107-6) both pairs finished on 11 points.

A big thank you to all those who did the weigh in, it took longer than normal due to the large numbers of fish caught.

All keepnets and landing nets to be fish friendly.

Barbless hooks only.

Fishery feed pellets only.

Maximum of 2 x 400g tins of Cat Meat or 3 x 300g tins of Luncheon meat.

No floating baits or surface fishing.

No handling the fish with dry or wet towels.

All litter must be put in bins provided on every peg.

No dogs, Pushchair's or bikes.

No Braid.

No Candles.

Groudbait in feeders and pole cups only.

Please have respect for fellow anglers.

EXTRA RULES FOR MATCHES ONLY

On arrival at your delegated peg, keepnets must be pegged out behind you.

No keepnets to be put in the water until start of the match.

Minimum of 2 keepnets to be used; one for silverfish and one for carp only.

Maximum of 80lb in any one net.
