It was close for the minor places with three teams ending on Nine points and they had to be separated by weight countback. After the calculators came out it was John Male and Ian Hughes who secured the second spot helped mainly by Ian who joined the ton club from peg 1 on Wyatts with 101-06. John lost a few lumps from peg 1 on the Oak pool be can feel well satisfied with 71-12.

Third place went to Bob Hinks and Rob Cox who both put over Eighty pounds on the scales from their respective pools. Bob was fishing just by the staged peg on The Oak to finish with 82-10 whilst his partner Rob managed just over 85 pounds from the end peg 15 on Wyatts.

Guest pairing of Paul Hotchkiss and Mark Watts where the unlucky team to finish on Nine points and miss out on the money. Paul used the margins well for 85-10 on The Oak and his partner put together 79-02 on the Wyatts Pool.
