Dave Skinner fishing on the same side of the pool as the winner also had a nice mixed bag for his 31-4 which was made up mainly of Carp. Dave used the feeder throughout the Five hour match and can be well pleased with the result of second place.

Paul Hotchkiss continued his good start to his first season with Exel Angling by finishing Third with 26-7. Paul regularly pleasure fishes Packington and only put three fish on the scales for his weight which included a nice 10 pound Carp.

John Male who was pegged on the far side of the lake used the pole to good effect and landed 21-3 for fourth position. John had plenty of open water in front of him on peg 23 but he ignored the feeder to catch mainly silvers.

Steve Cox drew the corner peg 16 and put 20-11 onto the scales for fifth place, while Alan Martin had a good day on the far side to finish sixth with 20-7 which included the biggest fish of the season so far a magnificent 11-8 Carp.

SINGLES

After two matches in the new Singles competition the four groups are looking interesting. Dave Crosby, John Male, and Kieran Smith all lead their respective Groups with 100% records.
