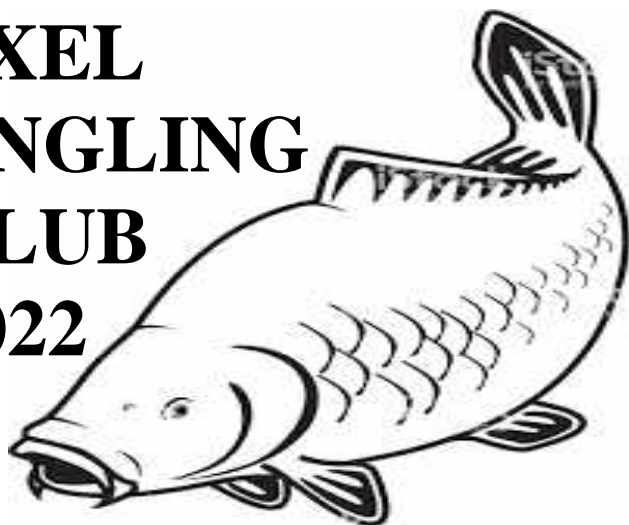

Rob had no joy on the feeder early doors but found the fish at 6 metres on maggot which included a few lumps.

Peter Bullock was struggling early on from peg 13 and like most changed to dead red maggots to land 40 pound 14 ounces to give him fourth place.

The two section prizes went to Frank Wallace with 37 pound 8 ounces and Martyn Harris who turned the scales to 34 pound 4 ounces.

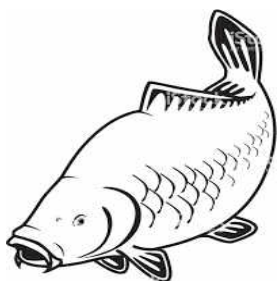
## CONGRATULATIONS RON EVANS
