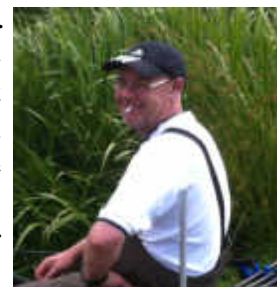

Kieran Smith and Juan Periera collected the section's prize money both landing one fish apiece. Kieran put a 10-8 lump in the net with Juan fish weighing in at 9-14.
