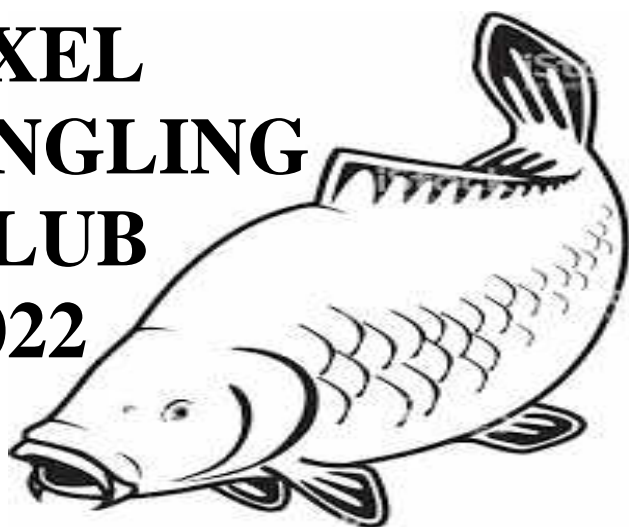

Rob used the long pole throughout the five hours and he stole the show when he entered the water to retrieve his pole, it's fitting that Rob will collect the Cox's Memorial Trophy for his victory which was donated by Rob in memory of his late Mother and Father.

Second place went to Michael Farrell who is having a great start to the 2022 season, Faz managed to put 121 pound 4 ounces onto the scales from peg 16. Michael used the pole at various distances and produced some lovely looking fish. Another member who's having a good start is Pete Bullock who collected the third place prize with 111 pound 10 ounces which comprised mainly of Carp and Barble. Pete looked very nimble when running to collect another keepnet at the back end of the match.

The two section envelopes went to Ron Evans who put 106 pound 9 ounces onto the scales from peg 11 and Frank Wallace from peg 14 who was disappointed not to reach the ton with 98-9.

Other stories from the match, both Paul Connell and Ian Rennie caught on the feeder all day ending the myth you cannot catch on Canal Lakes with the feeder.

Sophie Crumpton who had her operation cancelled on Friday put together a nice 80-07 weight from peg 22.

They say leave the best till last and that came from Colin Parsonage who seen his pole floating away with a tasty fish hooked. When we finally retrieved the pole his elastic snapped.

EARLY LEADERS

IMPORTANT CHANGES

Due to various reasons we have had to make a few changes to a couple of our forthcoming matches.

Solhampton Fishery (June 26th)

You may have heard but the Fishery has recently been sold, I have spoken to the old owner Burgess and I am glad to say our match will go ahead as planned.

Packington Fishery (July 10th)

Due to an admin error we have had to change the original pools booked, we are now fishing Anniversaries Pool (24 pegs) and Siblings B (17 pegs).

Lower Broadheath (August 21st)

We will now be fishing Sycamore Pool instead of the Old Pool, The Sycamore is a much bigger Pool giving us more space.

Bonehill Mill (October 16th)

Unfortunately the landlord has served notice on the fishery. I have spoken to Neil and he told me our match would be Ok to go ahead on the planned date. They are netting the pools in November and moving the fish, cafe, and tackle shop to the Catchmore Park Fishery in Kingsbury. I also asked Neil about our 2023 booking he told me that he hoped the Catchmore would be up and running well before then, so we will have to wait on that one.

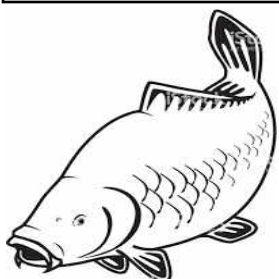

Strictly no dogs

No picnics on the banks

Please use toilets (by the cafe) and put litter in bins

Do not leave cigarette or litter on or by your peg

No landing nets or keepnets, the fishery provide both

All nets to be put away in net boxes as you find them

Any damages to nets to be paid for by the club or person

Barbless hooks only, maximum size 12, hook checks are made during matches

No floating baits

No Luncheon meat/Cat/Dog or any other meat

No Hemp or Groundbait

No Maccaroni or Pasta

No Bloodworm or Joker

No boilies

Bread is allowed but only punched

No floating pole / pole tapping or cupping of water

No elastics stronger than 16

No rhythm sticks or shock sticks

No elasticated method feeders

No feeder floats

No braided hook lengths or line

All pole rigs must have a fixed float 6" minimum from the tip of your pole

All fish to be netted, no swinging of fish

No mugging of fish

All feed pellets to be purchased from the fishery, hook pellets can be of your own choice

Solhampton Fishery Paste only

2 pint overall limit on Maggots and Casters, ½ Kilo worms

NO DEAD MAGGOTS

All fish to be weighed in using Fishery scales and bags
