Along with the winners envelope Faz will collect the Lee Wellard Trophy. Daz Haynes continued his fine start to the season by claiming the runners spot from peg 5. Daz like the winner used paste and caught consistently throughout the match and sent the scales around to 165 pound 12 ounces at the final whistle.

Ian Hughes is another member showing good form at present, he managed an excellent 121 pound 13 ounces from peg 9 to land third place. Ian started on the feeder across to the island and found some good fish in the margins late on.

The three section winners where Peter Bullock with 111 pound 11 ounces, Martyn Harris with 105 pound 5 ounces which included 66 pound plus of Silvers, Dave Skinner made up the trio with 74 pound 7 ounces.

A special word for Bill Gribon who put 104 pound 8 ounces onto the scales but missed out on the section prize because of Martyn's 105 pounds. Another good match at the excellent Alvechurch fishery.

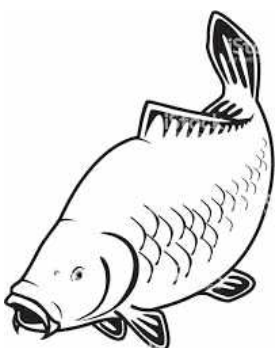

NO CAFE OR BAIT SHOP ON SITE**

Trout pellets, Trout pellet paste, Liquidised baits of any kind are not allowed and the maximum Permitted hook size is size 8.

Only carp pellets, maggots, worm, casters, luncheon meat, sweetcorn, hemp, cheese, prawn. Boilies, On the hook and sinking bread can be used for hookbait.

Minimum of two keepnets to be used, One for Carp the other for Silvers, Net limit is 60lb anything Over 60lb will not be counted.

Because of the possible danger to other anglers and animals, Luncheon meat, sweetcorn and other tins Should not be taken onto the fishery, and should instead be pre-prepared.

Lower Broadheath is an anglers only fishery – spectators are not allowed.

## How to get there

Lower Broadheath Fishery can be found off the B4204 Worcester to Martley, behind the Senoble Bakery

Turn into the complex with signs for Elizabeth the Chef, Senoble Broadheath and Vandemoortele.

Continue towards the rear of the bakery, at the Senoble reception turn right and continue to a sign directing you to 'fishing'
