Steve Kavanagh made a super start to the match from peg 32 hooking into two nice Carp within the first hour. When the carp dried up Steve relied on the silvers to take second place with 19-10.

Sean Durrant like the winner arrived late due to a misunderstanding regards the draw time. He made up for the late start by presenting a nice mixed bag to the scales which read 18-06 which was enough for third place.

Dave Skinner from peg 13 used the feeder throughout the match to land a useful 15-10 which put him in the frame in fourth place and he collected some cash at the end of the match. John Male's fine start to the season continued when he ended in fifth position with a bag full of silvers from the far end of the pool.

We had a tie for sixth with Mark Jones and Kieran Smith finishing with 11-08. Mark could not find the big Carp which were cruising around his peg, but Kieran found the biggest fish this season from peg 30 a 8-9 carp.
