Michael Farrell claimed his second win in a row when winning at Lower Broadheath Fishery on the Ash Pool. Michael showed us all of his skills when catching on various disciplines, Waggler, long Pole, short pole, and in the margins for a winning weight of 129 pound 14 ounces. Along with his winnings he will also collect the Friendship Trophy.

Fishing in the next peg to the winner Juan Periera stuck to the feeder and landed 86 pound 12 ounces which was enough for second place. Juan made use of the vacant peg across from his own peg 11 in the corner.

Third Place Frank Wallace struggled early on in the Five hour match from peg 15. He started the match on the feeder which he collected a few Carp but then things went wrong on the pole until he went in the margins for some late action and ended with 77 pound 8 ounces.

The Three sections winners all put over 60 pounds onto the scales. In the first section Sophie Crumpton finished with 60 pound 7 ounces, In the second section Rob Cox put just shy of 65 pound onto the scales which included a nice looking 13 pound lump. Martyn Harris completed the section winners with a nice looking net of fish which took the scales around to a level 61 pound.

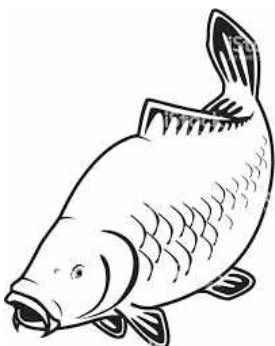

CAFE ON SITE

RULES

We operate a zero tolerance policy for any blatant disregard of our rules.

You will be asked to leave immediately and will be banned from using the fishery again.

Children must be supervised at all times

No dogs allowed at all times

No fires or BBQ's

No litter, please take all litter home with you

All fish to be netted

No parking on the grass with boots open, drop your tackle off at the peg then park up on the hard ground

No throwing of fish when returning to the water, pulled through nets and tipped please

No boilies of any size

No Bloodworm or Joker

Barbless hooks only, regular checks now in place, No larger than size 12

No floating baits

All pole float rigs must have a 6 inch minimum of line from the tip of your pole, and you must use a float

All forms of fixed leads and feeders must be free running (Guru X-safe system feeders can be used)

All fish to be netted no swinging

Please ensure all nets (Keep and Landing) are laid out and dried for 30 minutes before introduction to the water

Maximum of 60lbs in one net, If you go over 70lb in a match you go back to 60lb (Silver fish must be kept separate

to Carp)

BAITS THAT CAN BE USED

Maggots

Casters

Worms

Pellets (to 10 mm)

Luncheon Meat (No bigger than 10/12 mm cubes)

Hemp

Tares

Sweetcom

Paste

Groundbait
