We will be counting your individual results from all of this years matches and they will count towards the league tables. Please remember you will drop your worst result throughout the season and if for any reason you miss a match you will be awarded 10 points. If two or more are on the same number of points overall weight will decide the positions.

Frank Wallace leads the way in Division One after his win at Coppice, but the lead is only one point over previous leader Michael Farrell and I'm sure there will be many changes throughout the rest of the season between these two. Pete Bullock retains his third spot three clear of Ian Hughes who moved up the table with a good result at Coppice. Jeff Turner and Andy Taylor are level on 21 points, Ian Rennie is seventh on 35, Dave Skinner is eighth on 43.

Ron Evans extended his lead at the top of Division Two to five points but it's getting very tight between the chasing pack. Paul Connell moved from fourth to second after another fine match and he now holds a point advantage over Martyn Harris and Darren Bullock who are locked on 17. Steve Tayler is fifth on 22, Steve Cox is sixth, Brian Tovey is seventh with Colin Parsonage in eighth.

No changes at the top in Division Three, Simon Spence moved his lead to two points over second place Rob Cox who is four points better off than Daz Haynes who is in third spot. Sophie Crumpton remains in fourth followed by Nick Hull, then comes Dave Crosby who is a point clear of Juan Periera with John Male in Eighth.



#### **RULES**

- 1. Barbless hooks only. Size 10 maximum.
- 2. Mugging is allowed, but you must be seated.
- 3. All inline feeders are allowed.
- 4. All feeders and bombs must be free running.
- 5. No elasticated methods.
- 6. No floating baits or surface fishing.
- 7. No braid at all.
- 8. Minimum hooklength 4" (hybrid or method).
- 9. 16m pole limit.
- 10. No floating pole.
- 11. No tapping or cupping water.
- 12. Jigga is allowed but must be shotted properly.
- 13. No over shotting.
- 14. Minimum lash between pole tip and float 6".
- 15.Do not throw cigarette nubends in or around lakes.
- 16.Do not throw any unused bait in or around lakes.
- 17. Anyone found in breach of the above will be disqualified.

#### baits permitted

- 1. Fishery pellets 2mm 4mm 6mm 8mm.
- 2. Maggots.
- 3. Pinkies.
- 4. Squats.
- 5. Casters.
- 6. Worms (must be washed off before entering the lake).
- 7. Boilies.
- 8. Wafters.
- 9. Pop-ups & dumb bells (10mm max) Hook bait only.
- 10. Expanders & soft hookers.
- 11. Meat (no dog or cat meat).
- 12. Corn.
- 13. Hemp (if purchased on site).

#### net rules

- 1. 3 nets minimum. 50lb limit.
- 2. Silvers and carp under 2lb in separate net.
- Go over 70lb, lose whole net.
   Please make sure your nets are dry prior to entering the fishery where possible.
- 5. Please make sure all nets are strung out behind your peg on arrival and not put in the lake until 15 minutes before start.



#### **Bait limits for matches**

8 pints limit, which can include:

- 1. 8 pints of pellets (only 4 pints of 2mm).
- 2. 8 pints of casters.
- 3. 4 pints of maggots (dead or alive).
- 4. 3 pints of corn.
- 5. 2 tins of meat 250g, which is 2 pints cubed.
- 6. 1 pint of wet paste.
- 7. +1kg of worms on top of limit.
- 8. 2 tins of hempseed.

REGULAR CHECKS WILL BE MADE AND ANYONE FOUND BREAKING ANY RULE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND ASKED TO LEAVE.
