Pete Bullock landed a nice couple of carp in his 26 pound weight from peg 5 to collect second spot. Along with the carp Pete also netted some nice Ide amongst his silvers.

Juan Periera who was pegged next to Sean used the feeder throughout the match for a level 20 pound which was enough for third place.

Steve Cox picked up a rare envelope when finishing Fourth from the end peg 1. Steve sat for three hours before his first bite but made up for lost time with four carp which weighed 16-12.

Paul Hotchkiss finished fifth with Kieran Smith taking sixth **SINGLES;**

With just one group match remaining the Four semi-final spots are all up for grabs.

In Group A it's between Jim Barron and John Male who will progress with just two points separating them but Jim has the better overall weight at the moment.

Group's B & C are very close with three members in each all on 6 points with only weight the difference. In B its Steve Cox, Juan Periera, and Darren Bullock, with Steve and Darren meeting in the final match it could be interesting. In Group C Kieran Smith, Mary Turner, and Dave Crosby are level and it's funny how the fixtures turn out, Kieran will be up against Mary in the final match and all three are very close in the overall weights.

In Group D it will be a shoot out between Sean Durrant who is on Eight points and Paul Hotchkiss who has Six points. There is a big difference in the overall weight so I think Paul will have to win the match to progress and put a big weight onto the scales and hope Sean as an off day.

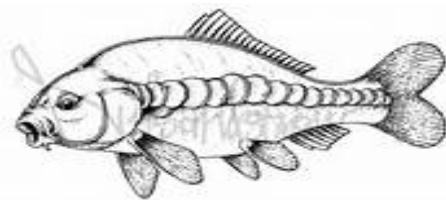
