THE LONG WAIT IS OVER COLIN CLAIMS VICTORY AT WOODLAND VIEW

***HIS FIRST INDIVIDUAL
WIN SINCE 2008***

Colin Parsonage will be celebrating tonight after claiming his first Individual win since October 2008 at Coppice Lane. Colin has won Doubles and Teams of Three events in that long wait but he finally put that to bed by winning at Woodland View with over Eight pound to spare. It did not start well for Colin from peg 9 losing two rigs in a matter of minutes but a change to the feeder changed his fortunes to put just over 66 pound onto the scales.

Juan Periera began the match in fine style, landing a number of fish in the first hour and like the winner he used the feeder throughout the contest and put an all carp net onto the scales for 58-06 which proved enough for second place.

Pegged on the far side of Front Deans Paul Hotchkiss continued his fine run of form taking third place with an ounce over 43 pound. Paul used the pole at various distances and the feeder to catch a mixed bag which included a nice lump.

Ian Rennie was also pegged on the far side at 22 just past the corner and was helped by a carp in the final minutes to secure Fourth spot with a useful 35-02. Peter Bullock was fifth with Ian Hughes in Sixth from peg 25.

SINGLES;

After the final group matches we now know the Semi-final line up for the 2018 BRS Shield. Although Jim Barron lost his final match to Pete Bullock he had sufficient overall weight to qualify where he will take on Juan Periera who took the honours in Group B again relying on better weight to progress.

Group C had an interesting finish with Mary Turner going through to the last four by defeating Kieran Smith, Dave Crosby could have joined Mary on Eight points but he could only manage a tie with Rob Cox so ended up a point short.

Although Paul Hotchkiss claimed a win against Sean Durrant in Group D he could not make up the weight difference to overtake the leader so it will be Sean who will meet Mary in the Semi-finals.

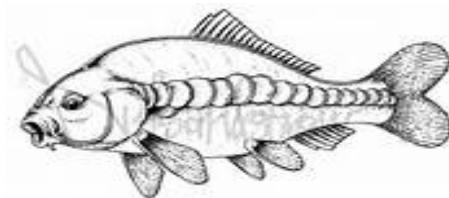
