Fishing from peg 19 Michael used a 4mm pellet throughout the match to land a mixed bag of Carp and Silvers.

Dave Skinner from Peg 1 picked up the runners-up prize with an all feeder catch of 97 pound 14 ounces. It's nice to see Dave back to his best after his long illness and I'm sure it will not be long before we see him pushing those in Division One again.

It was also nice to see Ian Rennie collecting some cash with his third place finish. Ian was in peg 7 and used a mixture of Feeder and pole for his 81 pound 14 ounces which was enough for the envelope.

The Three section winners today Daz Haynes in section One with just over 74 pound, Frank Wallace put over 71 pound onto the scales in section Two, and Bill Gribon picked section three with just over 55 pound.

We will be counting your individual results from all of this years matches and they will count towards the league tables. Please remember you will drop your worst result throughout the season and if for any reason you miss a match you will be awarded 10 points. If two or more are on the same number of points overall weight will decide the positions.

Michael Farrell extended his lead at the top of Division One to Five points after his win at Alvechurch. Frank Wallace remains in second spot on 15 points but he holds a 7 point lead over third placed Ian Hughes who's on 22. There where no changes to any of the positions after the last match so Martyn Harris is fourth on 26 followed by Ron Evans who is on 34. Peter Bullock is in Sixth place three clear of Andy Taylor who holds the same advantage over Jeff Turner.

Dave Skinner is the new leader of Division Two, he has collected two divisional wins from the last two matches which as enabled him to overtake Rob Cox at the top. Rob is just one behind with just two matches remaining it could be a tight finish. No changes to the other positions, Steve Cox is third on 22 but fourth placed Ian Rennie is closing the gap and is now just three behind. Simon Spence is fifth with 34 which is four clear of Paul Connell and Darren Bullock who both have 38.

Daz Haynes now holds a 7 point lead at the summit in Division Three, his divisional win at Alvechurch put him in a good position with just a couple of matches to go. It's getting very close for the second spot, Bill Gribon holds the second place with 23 which is just a single point clear of Nick Hull and Sophie Crumpton. Juan Periera is in fifth place on 33, Also on the same number of points is Steve Tayler but Juan has two divisional wins. Neil Ward is just a point behind on 34.



FISHING HIGH MEADOW CAFE & TACKLE SHOP ON SITE

RULES

- 1. Barbless hooks only. Size 10 maximum
- 2. Mugging is allowed, but you must be seated.
- 3. All inline feeders are allowed.
- 4. All feeders and bombs must be free running.
- 5. No elasticated methods.
- 6. No floating baits or surface fishing.
- 7. No braid at all.
- 8. Minimum hooklength 4" (hybrid ormethod).
- 9. 16m pole limit.
- 10. No floating pole.
- 11. No tapping or cupping water.
- 12. Jigga is allowed but must be shotted properly.
- 13. No over shotting.
- 14. Minimum lash between pole tip and float 6".
- 15.Do not throw cigarette nubends in or around lakes.
- 16.Do not throw any unused bait in or around lakes.
- 17. Anyone found in breach of the above will be disqualified.

BAITS ALLOWED

- 1. Fishery pellets 2mm- 4mm 6mm 8mm.
- 2. Maggots.
- 3. Pinkies.
- 4. Squats.
- 5. Casters.
- 6. Worms (must bewashed off before entering the lake).
- 7. Boilies.
- 8. Wafters
- 9. Pop-ups& dumb bells (10mm max) Hook bait only.
- 10. Expanders &soft hookers.
- 11. Meat (no dog or catmeat).
- **12.** Corn.
- 13. Hemp (if purchased on site).

MATCH BAIT LIMIT'S

8 pints limit, which can include:

- 1. 8 pints of pellets (only 4 pints of 2mm).
- 2. 8 pints of casters.
- 3. 4 pints of maggots (dead or alive).
- 4. 3 pints of corn.
- 5. 2 tins of meat 250g, which is 2 pints cubed.
- 6. 1 pint of wet paste.
- 7. +1kg of worms on top of limit.
- 8. 2 tins of hempseed.

NETS

- 1. 3 nets minimum. 50lb limit.
- 2. Silvers and carp under 2lb in separate net.
- 3. Go over 70lb, lose whole net.
- 4. Please make sure your nets are dry prior to entering the fishery where possible.
- 5. Please make sure all nets are strung out behind your peg on a rrival and not put in the lake until 15 minutes before start.

REGULAR CHECKS WILL BE MADE AND ANYONE FOUND BREAKING ANY RULE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND ASKED TO LEAVE.
