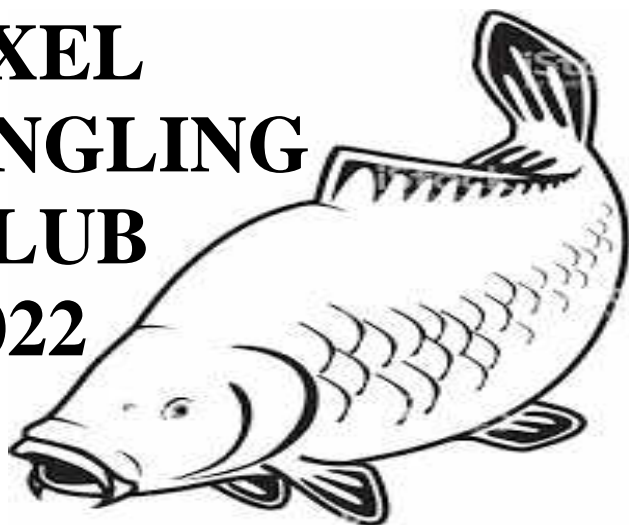

Daz Haynes who fished in the next peg to the winner collected the second place money. Daz matched the winner fish for fish until the last embers of the match where he could not get a bite on his paste attack but he still weighed in 96 pound 4 ounces.

Fishing just by the entrance on peg 28 Michael Farrell finished in third spot with 70 pounds 13 ounces. Faz fished most of the match on the feeder across to the island but changed to the pole on Paste to pick up a few lumps in the final hour.

Just three ounces behind Third place Faz was Simon Spence who fished from peg 13 on the left hand side of the lake. Simon fished various distances on the pole throughout the Five hour match putting 70 pound 10 ounces onto the scales at the final whistle.

Three section prizes at today's match, In section One Paul Connell collected the envelope with 47 pound 3 ounces. Martyn Harris did enough with a level 40 pound to win section two while in section three Jeff Turner produced 44 pound 8 ounces to win the cash.

A word for Ron Evans who finished sixth overall with 46 pound 1 ounce from peg 7.

We will be counting your individual results from all of this years matches and they will count towards the league tables. Please remember you will drop your worst result throughout the season and if for any reason you miss a match you will be awarded 10 points. If two or more are on the same number of points overall weight will decide the positions.

It's going to be an interesting last match of the season at Bonehill Mill with still lots to sort out regards promotion in all three divisions. With Frank winning the match at Alvechurch he now leads the first Division by virtue of having the best overall weight over Michael Farrell with both members on 16 points. So it's who finishes the highest in the final match will take the title. Pete Bullock still entertains third spot on 30 points and despite a poor match at Alvechurch Ian Hughes is still in fourth on 34. Andy Taylor is fifth on 36 and he is a point clear of Jeff Turner. Unfortunately Ian Rennie on 53 and Dave Skinner on 60 will be relegated.

Ron Evans is our Division Two Champion for 2022, he has been the most consistent throughout the season and will be a good addition to the First Division next term. Who goes up with Ron will be decided at Bonehill with three members still in the running for that second place. Paul Connell and Martyn Harris both have 25 points but Paul holds the better overall weight going into the decider. Darren Bullock on 29 points can still gate crash second spot depending on the results. There are no changes to the bottom half of the table Steve Cox is fifth on 38 followed by Steve Taylor on 42 the final two will be relegated Brian Tovey on 54 and Colin Parsonage on 64.

Division Three will go down to the wire to decide who wins the League and who comes runners-up. Rob Cox and Simon Spence are level on 16 points with Rob holding the better overall weight going into the decider. Daz Haynes could still gain promotion if sufficient numbers turn up to fish the final match, he trails the leaders by four points. Sophie Crumpton moved into fourth place with the better overall weight than Nick Hull who missed the Alvechurch match due to holidays. No changes to the final three Juan Periera 62 points, Dave Crosby 70 points, and John Male on 80 points.

It was nice to see John Male having a walk around Alvechurch passing on a few tips along the way. If everything falls into place John will try and fish the final match at Bonehill. John please remember your health comes first.

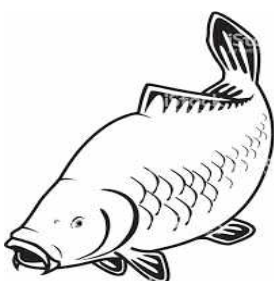

- There must be a minimum of 10? between your float and hook
- No handling fish in towels
- No litter
- Keepnets are only to be used in matches
- In matches, silvers and carp should be split
