The Three Divisions are still undecided with just the Sion Farm match remaining.

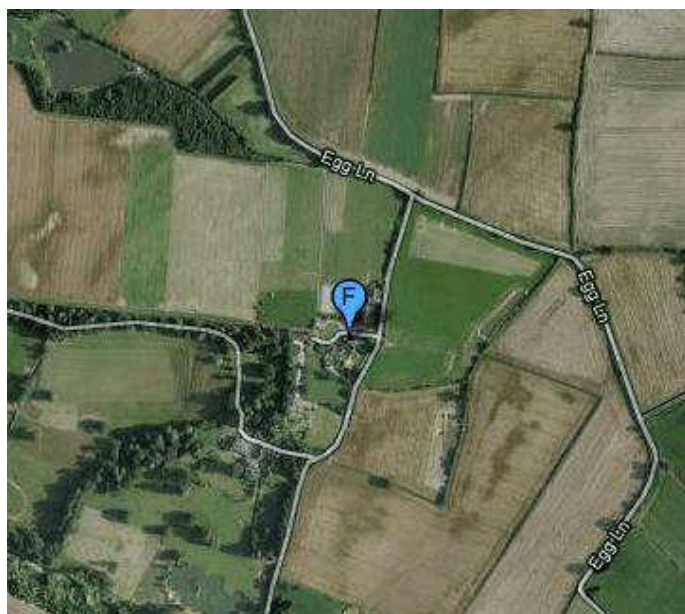
