Some 16 pounds behind the winner and in second place was Sean Durrant from Peg 7. Sean followed up his victory in the first match of the season with another solid performance which included an 8lb Carp.

Mark Jones who fished on the far side of the pool from peg 20 collected third place with a mixed bag for 22-8. Mark alternated on the long pole and feeder and caught consistently throughout the Five hour match.

Dave Crosby (pictured right) made the frame In Fourth spot, fishing from peg 6 near the entrance Crocker traded fish for fish early on with Sean Durrant in the next peg but a poor last hour put Pay to an higher finish.



The two new members to the club this season had A close tussle for the fifth and sixth spots. It was Jeff Turner who just came out on top by four ounces from peg 22. Jeff put a nice mixed bag on the scales for 19-8 which was just enough to keep Paul Hotchkiss at bay from end peg 26.

GEARYS LEVEL POOL



RULES

All anglers must be in possession of a current EA Rod Licence.

Barbless hooks only, maximum size 10

No braided line of any form to be used

Tackle must not be left unattended

No fires, dogs, bikes or loud Radios

Fishing from designated pegs only

No keepnets to be used except in matches.

Cat/dog food can only be used on the hook not loose fed.

No halibut, trout or high oil pellets

ADDITIONAL RULES

FOR MATCHES

Keepnets must be laid out to dry and not put into the water until 15 minutes before the match starts

60lb weight limit per net

Floating baits must not be fed, can be used on the hook

A float must be used when fishing the pole.

Rules can be changed at any time
