He collects his first Individual win



All anglers must be in possession of a current EA Rod Licence.

Barbless hooks only, maximum size 10 No braided line of any form to be used Tackle must not be left unattended No fires, dogs, bikes or loud Radios Fishing from designated pegs only No keepnets to be used except in matches.

Cat/dog food can only be used on the hook not loose fed.

No halibut, trout or high oil pellets

# ADDITIONAL RULES FOR MATCHES

Keepnets must be laid out to dry and not put into the water until 15 minutes before the match starts

60lb weight limit per net

Floating baits must not be fed, can be used on the hook

A float must be used when fishing the pole.

Rules can be changed at any time
