DAVE SKINNER WINS AT WILLOW MARSH

Dave Skinner continued his fine form of late by winning our fifth contest of the 2014 season at a disappointing Willow Marsh. All those taking part struggled on the Sandpipers Pool which looked full of fish when the draw was made. Dave stuck his trusted feeder approach from peg 10 and caught an all Carp net of fish which pushed the scales to 31-0 at the weigh in.

Rob Cox fished the corner peg 22 and collected the second spot with 24-8. Rob used the feeder and pole throughout the match and landed two stunning Carp which included the biggest fish of the season a 12-6 Carp which took him an age to land on the pole.

Ian Rennie found the fish hard to find early on from his island peg 29 perhaps it was because he spent a lot of time in the overhanging bushes. Ian finished the match well to pick up the third spot with 21-12.

Sean Durrant moved six points clear at the top of Division One with yet another good performance. Sean caught most of his fish on the feeder which pushed the scales to 19-4 enough to give him fourth place.

Dave Robinson got his promotion push back on track finishing in Fifth place with 13-0 and Colin Parsonage had his best finish of the season in Sixth.

SINGLES

We have two new group leaders with just one match to go in the group stages. Rob Cox beat the previously unbeaten Dave Crosby in Group A and now leads the way by virtue of overall weight.
